That night all the people of the community raised their voices and wept aloud. All the Israelites grumbled against Moses and Aaron, and the whole assembly said to them, "If only we had died in Egypt! Can you picture that moment described above? Would you agree that it is <u>vital that we surround ourselves with others</u> <u>who will reinforce</u> the blessings and promises of God, rather than promote fear and discouragement? We are all human and the tendency of all of us is to "go back to Egypt" when difficulties arise in our journey of faith.
